1. Special Policy Area (premises licences and club certificates)

1.1 The premises are not in the special policy area.

2. Type of hearing and powers of the sub-committee

2.1 The sub-committee is required to determine the application by taking such of the steps set out below as it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives.

2.2 In making their determination the sub-committee must have regard to the Licensing Act 2003, the licensing objectives, guidance issued by the Secretary of State and Merton's Licensing Policy.

2.3 Variation of premises licence: s35

(i) To modify the conditions on the licence

(ii) To reject the whole or part of the application.

3. Hearing papers

3.1 The applications, notices and representations for determination by the sub-committee are contained in the hearing bundles together with any relevant existing licence. This includes any documents which must be sent to any of the parties to the hearing under Regulation 7(2) and Schedule 3 of The Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005. This bundle has been issued to all parties to the hearing.

4. Legal advice to the sub-committee

4.1 A legal officer appointed by the Assistant Director of Corporate Governance and Head of Legal Services will attend the hearing to advise the sub-committee on statutory provision and legal matters.

5. Licensing Officer comments

5.1 This application is to vary an existing premises licence.

5.2 The application seeks to amend the plan. The plan submitted would appear to be the same as the one attached to the licence at the moment, except for a florescent green line outlining the front outside area. The applicant states that no licensable activities are proposed in the external area.

5.3 They also wish to alter the opening times to allow for earlier opening, remove non-standard hours and change two conditions.

- 5.4 Changing condition 3 would allow for the use of the outside area between 10:00 and 23:00 Monday to Saturday, 22:30 on Sunday. No use can be made of the outside areas at the moment save the rear yard for smoking only. The variation would also seek to delete this condition – condition 9.
- 5.5 A more comprehensive condition regarding CCTV is also requested.
