



# Raynes Park Local Flooding Update

#### Actions completed since previous Community Forum

Maintaining operation of our assets and proactive sewer cleaning.

#### **Next Steps**

 Progressing a strategic approach to investigate long term solutions (DWMP) for 2025 onwards.




## **DWMP Next steps**

We are carrying out similar sessions with all LLFAs in our region up to December 2020.

The areas of interest/vulnerability we agree in these sessions will be prioritised in the next stage of our DWMP planning process – Optioneering.

In this next stage, following the collation of the outputs of these workshops on the BRAVA data, we will be looking for partnership-led, collaborative projects which work to improve the risk level in the agreed key areas across our region.
